The announcement comes at a crucial time, as February marks **Teen Dating Violence Awareness Month (TDVAM)**. Teen dating violence is a widespread issue, affecting youth across all backgrounds. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC):

- 1 in 3 U.S. teens experience physical, emotional, or verbal abuse from a dating partner before adulthood.
- 1 in 12 high school students experience physical dating violence annually.
- Nearly half of teens in abusive relationships never tell anyone about the abuse.

Through this partnership, Alternative House will work closely with GLTHS to equip students with the knowledge and tools to recognize unhealthy behaviors, seek support, and build healthy relationships. The program will include workshops on consent, boundaries, red flags of abuse, and how to support friends who may be experiencing dating violence.

"We are thrilled to partner with Greater Lowell Technical High School to continue these critical conversations with young people," said Maria Crooker-Capone; Executive Director of Alternative House. "By educating students about healthy relationships early, we can empower them to make safe choices and prevent future cycles of abuse."
